



Leaders who anticipate a ransomware attack will bring down a critical piece of national infrastructure – e.g., a utility company, bank, or transportation network – within the next two years




Cybersecurity leaders who lost confidence in their cyber insurance


Cybersecurity leaders who felt personally responsible for a breach in 2021
